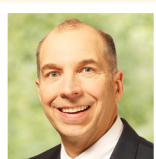

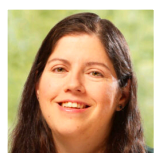

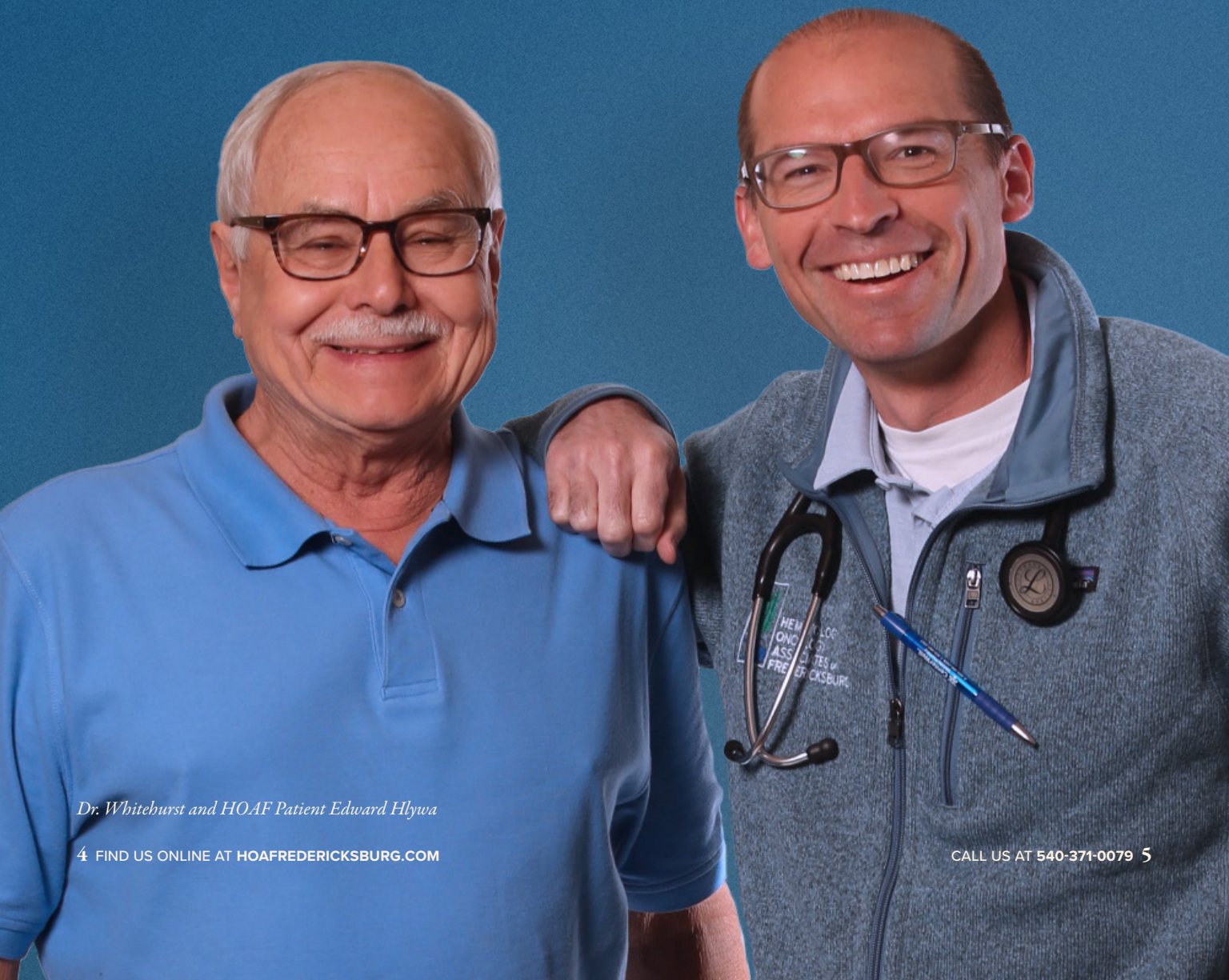

Our Services

MEDICAL ONCOLOGY

Medical oncology is the treatment of cancer with medicine such as chemotherapy, biotherapy, immunotherapy, and hormones. Our medical oncologists coordinate and direct your medical care in collaboration with your referring physician and other specialists.

HEMATOLOGY

We provide hematology services, including the treatment of coagulation and clotting disorders as well as diseases related to blood and bone marrow.

INFUSION

Our facility offers a range of innovative infusion therapies in a tranquil setting, including chemo-biotherapy, iron infusions, immunotherapy, antibiotics, and hydration therapy.

CHEMOTHERAPY

We offer multiple cancer treatment options, from traditional chemotherapy to advanced immune and biotherapies. We also work with multiple pharmaceutical companies and tertiary centers to provide our patients access to clinical trials through our facility.

CLINICAL TRIALS

We are committed to offering our patients the most advanced comprehensive cancer care. We currently have multiple trials open for enrollment—see our full list at hoafredericksburg.com.

IRON REPLACEMENT

We offer intravenous iron replacement therapy for our cancer and blood disorder patients.

PRESCRIPTION SERVICES

For our patients' convenience, HOAF provides on-site prescription services for oral therapies, as well as any supportive medicines you may need during your care.

PALLIATIVE CARE

HOAF's palliative care program is an extra layer of support as you go through treatment of advanced cancer. Our services include pain and symptom management, advanced care planning, and psychosocial support for both patients and family.

CO-PAY ASSISTANCE

We understand the financial burden of cancer care on our patients and their families. HOAF will work with you to coordinate co-pay assistance whenever possible.

TREATMENT SIDE-EFFECT MANAGEMENT

During the course of your treatment, our clinical staff proactively manages any side effects or complications you may experience. We make every effort to treat you at our facility to help you avoid costly emergency room visits.

SURVEILLANCE CLINIC

The Surveillance Clinic, which opened at our Fredericksburg location in 2018, is an acute care clinic serving the urgent needs of all HOAF patients, including those at our Stafford location, experiencing problems or symptoms related to their cancer treatment or diagnosis. We see patients on a walk-in basis, no appointment necessary.
